

## Rules of Sponsorship

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**ASV Members** with current full-member status may **sponsor** scientific abstracts for oral workshop and poster sessions at the Annual Meeting. The **role of the sponsor** of an abstract is to serve as a reviewer of the science, to ensure that it is at a stage where it can be shared with the public. A **current full member** is one who has received notification of membership in the Society and whose payment of the 2019 membership dues has been received by the ASV Secretary-Treasurer's office. Payment of dues must be up-to-date to maintain current member status. To verify your membership status, check your membership account at [members.asv.org](http://members.asv.org) or contact the office of the ASV Secretary-Treasurer, Dr. Katherine R. Spindler:

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**Non-Members, Associate Members and Student Members** may submit an abstract to the annual meeting ONLY if a current full member of ASV sponsors the abstract. Non-members who wish to apply for membership in the American Society for Virology may apply online prior to the February 1st deadline for abstract submissions through the ASV web site ([www.asv.org](http://www.asv.org)). New applicants for *full membership status* must have received an email confirmation of their acceptance as full members of the Society *and* submit payment of their 2019 membership dues *before* they can sponsor an abstract.
